

Garreth Bloor is an elected public representative in the City of Cape Town and a member of the Mayor's cabinet for Tourism, Events and Economic Development. He was previously the Mayoral Committee member for Economic, Environmental and Spatial Planning.

Cllr Bloor has undergraduate and graduate degrees from the University of Cape Town, where he is currently a member of the university council. He has participated in programs at Princeton and Oxford and is a faculty member and speaker at several academic and economic policy symposia.
