

WINE TOUR

Your guide will pick you up at 9:00 from your accommodation.



First we will visit the beautiful Neethlingshof wine estate, steeped in history. We travel up the imposing stoney pine avenue to the Cape Dutch buildings, for a cellar tour and tasting. Here we will learn a little more about wine making at the Cape.



Then, leaving Neethlingshof behind, we will travel to Franschhoek. Franschhoek is known as the French corner. Here, 300 years ago, people fleeing Europe because of their religious beliefs found refuge. Franschhoek is the gourmet

capital of South Africa and we can do a walk-about town and after having had a look at the historic sites or a bit of shopping, we will commence to La Motte wine estate, where we have lunch and if you wish, taste some of the Franschoek Wines.



After lunch we make our way to Boschendal – with it's 300ha it is one of the oldest farms in South Africa. Here we can sit under the old oak tree (weather permitting) and have another wine tasting.

Our wine tour will end between 17:00 and 18:00 when we deliver you safely back to your accommodation at Spier.
